6. Questions and answering in MCQs of written papers
 - a) The MCQ answer sheet should be filled ● with ink/ ball point pen of the same black color.
 - b) The particular MCQ answer/s shall be considered invalid if pencil or correcting fluid or different colors of pen is used
7. A candidate found guilty of any of the following shall be deemed to have used unfair means and his/her examination shall be liable to be cancelled. He/She may further be debarred from appearing at any examination of the University for, a Period up to 5 years.
